

VFA Restructure Proposal



- Organisational restructure presented to staff on 13 February
- Proposed changes include:
 - Closure of 5 existing fisheries officer stations to be replaced with 3 community hubs
 - Significant reduction in fisheries officers around Port Phillip Bay and Western Port Bay areas
 - Greater focus on education and public engagement
 - Reductions in science, management and licencing teams
 - Overall reduction in approximately ¼ of total VFA staff
