Fisheries Victoria Half Yearly Aquaculture Production Return

For use by all CLB and CLOS aquaculture licence holders

If you hold both CLB and CLOS licences you must complete a return for each licence.

Note: A half-yearly aquaculture production return must be completed for each licence held and forwarded to the Catch and Effort Unit within thirty days of the end of the reporting period. Licence holders are required to keep a copy of their Aquaculture Production Return.

1. Source and destination
