

## Fisheries Regulations 2019

### EXEMPTION NOTICE

Pursuant to regulation 463 of the **Fisheries Regulations 2019** (the Regulations) the Victorian Fisheries Authority EXEMPTS the holder of Sea Urchin Fishery Access Licence [*licence number*] from the following licence condition set out in the Regulations, for the period specified below and subject to any conditions listed below:

#### Exempt Condition(s)

Regulation 411(d) – the engagement of no more than three licence operators.

#### Circumstances in which the exemption applies

This exemption applies where the licence holder undertakes activities authorised by the licence.

#### Place at which the exemption applies

This exemption applies in the sea urchin commercial fishery management zone specified in the licence.

#### Period During Which the Exemption Applies

This exemption is in force from the date it is issued to 30 June 2025, unless cancelled sooner by the Victorian Fisheries Authority.

#### Conditions of Exemption

This exemption is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The licence holder must not engage more than seven licence operators;
- (2) The licence operator must ensure that before commencing a fishing trip that the licence operator sets up the fishing trip in the e-catch system of the Victorian Fisheries Authority.

Note:

If a licence holder (or person acting under the licence) does not comply with an exemption from a condition of the licence, the exemption will no longer be of any effect and the licence holder will have to comply with that condition. Non-compliance with a condition of a licence is an offence under section 53 of the Act, various penalties apply.
