Banded Morwong Fishery

I, Luke O'Sullivan, Acting Chief Executive Officer, Victorian Fisheries Authority, as delegate of the Minister for Outdoor Recreation, having undertaken consultation in accordance with section 3A of the **Fisheries Act 1995**, make the following Further Quota Order under section 64A of the Act for the Banded Morwong Fishery.

- 1. This Order applies for the period commencing 1 January 2025 and ending 31 December 2025, both dates inclusive (the quota period).
- 2. The total allowable commercial catch for the banded morwong fishing zone is 2,044 fish.
- 3. Individual quota units equate to 0.7 fish per quota unit.

Note: As specified in the Initial Quota Order, Banded Morwong Fishery Access Licences are issued to two licence holders with quota units being apportioned between the two licences. There are a total of 2,920 quota units for the Banded Morwong Fishery.

FISHERIES (BANDED MORWONG) NOTICE 2025

1. Title

This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Banded Morwong) Notice 2025.

2. Objectives

The objective of this Notice is to set the closed season for banded morwong to be the period beginning 1 March and ending 30 April. Other existing restrictions still apply.
