## FISHERIES (BANDED MORWONG) NOTICE 2025

## 1. Title

This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Banded Morwong) Notice 2025.

# 2. Objectives

The objective of this Notice is to set the closed season for banded morwong to be the period beginning 1 March and ending 30 April. Other existing restrictions still apply.

## 3. Authorising provision

This Notice is made under sections 67 and 152 of the Act.

#### 4. Commencement

This Notice comes into operation on the date it is published in the Government Gazette.

# 5. Definitions

In this Notice -

'banded morwong' means Cheilodactylus spectabilis;

'the Act' means the Fisheries Act 1995.

# 6. Closed season for banded morwong

(1) The licence holder must not take banded morwong during the period beginning 1 March and ending on 30 April each year.

## 7. Revocation

Unless sooner revoked, this Fisheries Notice will be automatically revoked on the day which is 12 months after the date on which it comes into operation.

**Note:** Under section 152(3) of the Act, if a provision of this Notice is inconsistent with any regulations, the Fisheries Notice prevails to the extent of the inconsistency.
