We would like to trial

If fishing 2 licences from one boat, we don't have to land the fish after the first 2 shots.. but could use a coded cable tie and a time dated photo perhaps to identify and seal which licence the fish were caught on. And then be able to continue the day fishing.

To come in and unload at best takes 1 and a half hours and intense physical and mental strength trying to catch the tide before it is too high and fast...

Basically like this..

1st shot 2hours before low tide

2nd shot finish 2 hours after the low tide

End of licence for example.. seal and tag

At this point it is still feasible to do the 3rd shot on the second licence with tide high and water pressure...

Even if using this system we could at least shoot 1 shot on the second licence , it could really help.

Working 2 boats 2 crews or two sets of tides for us is not an option without taking a heavy toll with burnout....there could be such a simple solution.
