Overview of 2023 RLRAG



Key Discussion Items

1. Management Plan

- RLRAG input into new Management Plan
- RLRAG endorsement of final draft plan

2. Harvest Strategy Development

- RLRAG input into development of new harvest strategy
- Introduction of a formalised recreational allocation
- Introduction and application of revised strategy in setting TACCs based on 20-year rebuilding targets

3. Australian Rock Lobster Model

- Discussion of the application of the new model
- Assessment of the model alongside the current model

4. Giant Crab e-Monitoring Project

- Introduction of electronic monitoring on-board GC vessels operating offshore
- Improvements in compliance capabilities for offshore fishery

5. Giant Crab data collection project

- Victoria's involvement in multi-jurisdictional FRDC project
- Focused on the use of 3D imaging equipment for data collection on giant crab and rock lobster
 - Project considers length frequency data and possible identification

Key Discussion Items

6. Amendments to Rock Lobster Recreational Reporting Program

- Development and implementation of new reporting app
- Focus on simplification and improvement in levels of reporting

7. Development of Recreation Measuring Device

8. Eastern Zone Fee Relief

- \$150,000 fee relief package allocated across three seasons
- Reduction in VFA services relating to compliance and observer coverage
- Reduction in stock assessment services
- Temporary solution during ministerial review of the cost recovery model

9. Puerulus Monitoring Program

- Discussion regarding ongoing use of crevice collectors compared to basket collection
- Consideration for crevice collector calibration with SA program ultimately not deemed cost effective
- Final consensus to proceed only with basket collectors

10. AVG Outbreak

- Effects on the rock lobster industry
- Likely to be an ongoing consideration
- FRDC project application to consider level of risk associated with rock lobster gear in transmitting virus

- Aim to improve accurate reporting through the RL reporting program
