Victoria Fisheries Authority Half Yearly Aquaculture Production Return

Note: A half-yearly aquaculture production return must be completed for each licence held and forwarded to the Catch and Effort Unit within thirty days of the end of the reporting period. Licence holders are required to keep a copy of their Aquaculture Production Return.

The live weight or equivalent at time of harvest. In the case where the production moved from the licensed area are bivalve spat collected on ropes or droppers report the total length in metres of the ropes or droppers moved to another licensed area for grow-out.
