Abalone Data Flow for Quota Management

Place of landing

Must land at place listed in schedule 3: reg 261(a)

Weighing

Must be weighted:

- within 60 min of landing at place of landing
- in full public view which is unobstructed: reg 261 (c)

Recorded weight must be accurate to within 1kg: reg: 263 (2)

Seal bins or bags

Prior to removal from boat:(reg 260): Bins:

- each bin sealed with 1 or 2 bin tags sealing lid
- must not be able to add or remove abalone or lid without breaking seal: (reg 259 (1)

Bags:

- 1 tag sealing bag
- must not be able to add or remove abalone without breaking seals (reg 259(1)

After sealing

Ensure:

- that the bin tag is not removed, damaged or broken
- that no abalone is removed from, or added to, the bin or bag: reg 259 (2)

Complete abalone docket

At place of landing (reg 260)

1st -Part A (original & quadruplicate): reg 262

2nd-Part B (all copies) once the abalone has been weighed and no later than 60 mins after the time the abalone is landed:

- Serial numbers of all bin tags of abalone landed under the licence
- Total tare weight of those bins or bags
- Net weight of the abalone
- All other details required by Part B
 of the abalone docket including
 signature (or signature of person
 who took the abalone): reg
 263(1)(a)

Notify AQMS

- Once abalone has been weighed and no later than 60 mins after time that abalone is landed provide specified details confirmed as correct via the abalone telephone notification service
- Record confirmation no. on Part B of abalone docket: reg 263 (1)(b)

Transport

- Duplicate and triplicate of abalone docket placed in waterproof envelope attached to highest no. bin tag
- Must be transferred or delivered to the holder of a fish receivers licence no later than 24 hours after the time the abalone is landed

Receivers compliance check

- Must receive within 24 hours of landing
- If bin not properly sealed must notify Sec within 30 mins and not open any other bins in consignment
- If Part B of abalone docket not completed, must notify Sec within 15 mins

Receiving process

As soon as practicable but not more than 25 hours after landing:

- Weigh it and enter net weight on Part C of the duplicate and triplicate copies of the abalone docket and complete all other details (except notification service details) required by Part C of the docket
- Provide specified details to AQMS
 Before breaking any bin tags or adding or removing any abalone from a bin or bag:
- Receive and record confirmation number in Part C of abalone docket
- Sign abalone docket

Labelling

Before abalone leaves premises:

- Must mark outside of the immediate packaging of the abalone with prescribed details, or
- Affix a label to the outside of the immediate packaging of the abalone that contains the prescribed details

Sale process

If not more than 5kg

- Issue a receipt at time of sales return
- Enter details small sales return
 If more than 5kg
- Complete part A of ATC
- Notify AQMS
- Record confirmation number on ATC
- Send duplicate and triplicate of ATC with consignment

Trader receives abalone

- Must keep document regarding receipt: reg 283
- Must fall within exemption ie receipt/ATC
- Must dispose of abalone within time limit prescribed by exemption

Trader sells abalone

- Must issue receipt: reg 307
- Must fall within exemption for possession limits: DIv 8
- Abalone must have been packaged by fish receiver

Consumer receives abalone

- Must fall within exemption (ie receipt/ATC)
- Must not open packaging or remove or destroy label until at place of consumption
